
"Struck-by" Crashes

- During the period from 2015-2019, there were
 70 crashes in which an officer, while on foot or outside of their police vehicle, was struck and killed by a vehicle.
- This type of traffic-related death represents
 28% Of all traffic-related deaths during the period.





Struck-by Crashes 2015-2019

- **34** were felonious
- 36 were deemed accidental
 - 12 of the striking drivers were impaired
 - 4 were confirmed to be distracted
 - 24 cases involved a violation of the "Slow Down and Move Over Laws of that state






Additional Circumstances

- 6 of the officers killed were struck while deploying or removing tire deflation devices
- 5 of the crashes were the result of adverse weather conditions, such as ice, snow or heavy rain.





NHTSA Regions





Key Take-aways

- 28% of all fatal crash types were Struck-by crashes
- 34% of struck-by crashes involved a "Slow Down and Move Over" violation
- 46% of officers struck were engaged in some type of traffic enforcement





Solutions

- Wear your reflective vest
- Tactically position your vehicle
- Conduct right-side (Passenger) approaches
- Conspicuously mark your vehicles with reflective striping.
